







Facts you should know about bladder cancer

**Bladder cancer is not a rare cancer
But not many people have heard about it**

-  Bladder cancer is one of the ten most common cancers in the UK
-  Anyone can get bladder cancer – men or women
-  Bladder cancer is often diagnosed late (particularly in women) and has one of the highest diagnosis upon emergency admission rates in the UK
-  In the UK there are over 10,200 new cases each year – half of those diagnosed will die
-  There have been no significant new treatments for bladder cancer for over 30 years
-  Bladder cancer receives little research funding - it receives only 0.6% of cancer research funding in the UK despite the level of incidence

For every breast cancer patient it's £1,400 a year

For a prostate cancer patient it's £490

Bladder cancer is just £20
